6. **Cross Country/Track – Boys** - The district meet was held at Northwest Park in La Porte on Wednesday, October 28th. The Varsity, JV, and Freshmen boys teams all placed first in district. Varsity boys competed at the Region 3 meet in Huntsville on Monday, November 9th. For the first time since 2012, Friendswood placed first in the region. The team is undefeated this season and will race 11 other teams for the 5A state title on Monday, November 23rd.

The girls and boys cross country team won "Most Spirited Float" at the Homecoming Parade. Our Jog-A-Thon fundraiser will be held Saturday, December 5th at 9am at the stadium. Athletes are soliciting donations or pledges per lap run during the hour long event.
