- 6. Cross Country/Track Boys (Karg/) The Friendswood Mustang Boys Track & Field team competed in the District 22-5A Track & Field Championships at Santa Fe HS April 7-8. The boys came away with a strong second place finish, behind the Mavericks of Manvel. Alberto Orta was the District Champion in both discus and shot. Seth Thompson was the District Champion in the 1600m and Eli Karg was the District Champion in the 3200m. Several athletes placed in the top 4 in their event, qualifying for the Area 21/22 Meet on April 15th at Barbers Hill. The boys had another strong showing at the Area Meet, finishing a close 2nd as a team, in a very competitive 16 team field. Athletes finishing 1-4 in their events will be moving on to compete in the Region III 5A Track & Field Championships in Humble this Friday and Saturday. Alberto Orta was the Area Discus Champion, Seth Thompson was the Area Champion in the 1600m, and Zade Kayyali was the 3200m Area Champion. Also qualifying for the Regional Meet is Patrick Elizondo, Eli Karg, Seth Spruiell, Kade Stevens, and Karmine Stevens. The boys cross country and track teams will have an end of season celebration on Tuesday, May 4th at Pearwood Skate Center. This event will be held in conjunction with the girls track and cross country teams. This event will be limited to varsity and senior athletes.
