iii. President's Report -

a. Thank you to Ava, Jackie, Sam, Felicity, and all others who helped pull off a successful Casino Night event! This was a great first-year effort and we're excited to offer this in future years

iv. 1st Vice President's Report –

- a. We appreciate all of the support and contributions to make Casino Night successful! We sold approx 120 tickets less than we had hoped for, but overall the event was a major success! Total money raised was \$27,195.20.
- b. Ticket sales- 119 tickets sold for a total of \$22,000
- c. Silent Auction- \$7050 (21 baskets)
- d. Drink tickets and raffle tickets- approx \$1200
- e. Each sport (with the exception of FJH swim) received \$1425 from the event.
- f. We are discussing ways to improve the event for next year and can't wait to see the growth in the event, to be able to give each sport even more money.

v. Treasurer's Report -

- **a.** Accounts have been reconciled and certified through November 2021.
- **b.** Today's bank account is \$265,229.09. All checks and deposits have been processed. Please make sure that y'all are utilizing the tax exemption form, as a reminder, we can not reimburse sales tax.
- c. Concessions Report Everyone is doing an amazing job with providing volunteers. Your volunteers have been awesome with running and clean-up of the stands. Thank you all. Please remember when scheduling that the end time posted on the calendar is only an estimate. Volunteers need to stay until they are released by the hosting sport's VP. We are currently sitting at \$11,942.37 in expenses. \$8240.94 of that is drink orders directly related to the split with Band for the Football season. We are still waiting for band to finalize their numbers. So far, our non-Football concessions have brought back in \$5563.22. Keep up the good work.

vii. Robert Koopman – Athletic Director

- **a.** Coaches had nothing but positive feedback about Casino Night. Many went to school on Monday telling other coaches they missed a great time. They are looking forward to next year and appreciate all the effort that went into the event.
- b. We are at our quietest time of the year until the New Year, but after the start of the year we're at our busiest.
- c. UIL Updates Every 2 years, UIL examines enrollment for classes and districts. At FHS, 1,976 enrolled currently, which puts us at the lower end of the 5A class for 2022-2024. We will know what district we're in mid-Feb; football and all other sports will likely be in different districts again. Right now, Class 6A ranges from 2275 up to 7000 students. Given this huge range of student enrollment, there is talk of creating a Class 7A in 2024

viii. 2nd Vice Presidents – Reports

- **1.** Baseball Baseball agrees with the P/L. We are in motion on a February 5th event focused on community involvement, and team building. Details to follow. Last day of practice in January 28 with our first scrimmage at home on February 14th.
- 2. Basketball Men's basketball is 8-8 on the season coming off of a HUGE win against Goose Creek. Our big fundraiser was run through a new company "TEAM DRIVEN" (think fan angel) We were able to raise \$6000. We have plenty of home games left and hope all of you can make it out! PNL is reconciled
- 3. Basketball Girls Girls Basketball is undefeated in district play at all levels. Varsity placed 3rd in Silver bracket at the Ft Bend ISD tournament and 2nd in Gold bracket at the Barbers Hill tournament. Freshman placed 2nd in the Barbers Hill Tournament as well. We had a successful teacher appreciation night on 12/7 35 teachers attended and were recognized on the court with the girls. PNL is reconciled
- 4. Cross Country Girls Our season is over, so we don't have much to report, other than that we are looking to host a Jog-A-Thon possibly in January like we did last year to raise funds, as our account is a meager \$152.
- 5. Track Girls Girls track will be having a team meeting on January 12th. Our fan t-shirt orders were due and are being processed. We are looking forward to getting the track season started in the next few months! Will be in the red once casino night funds are deposited. PNL is reconciled
- 6. Country/Track Boys The Boys' Cross Country team finished up a great season with their banquet on November 16. It was held at Golf Crest with nearly 100 in attendance from both the boys' and girls' teams. All of the runners were individually commended by the coaches and many of the seniors gave speeches recognizing the impact that the coaches and the sport have had on their lives over the last four years. It was a great evening enjoyed by all and a wonderful way to end a successful season.
- 7. Cheerleaders The girls are continuing to work hard. They will be practicing during the break as they compete at State in Fort Worth on January 14th and again at NCA Nationals on January 22nd & 23rd, which will conclude their season. PNL is reconciled
- 8. Football Our PNL is balanced. Football had our end of season banquet, on December 8 where we recognized 29 seniors. We had 19 players named to All District teams, including Matthew Reyes, who was named district defensive MVP, and the coaching staff won Coaching Staff of the Year. - 16.Tennis We are in our off-season, so things slow down for a bit, but a few things are happening on in November/December: Our All-District honors were voted on by all of the district tennis coaches, and the vast majority of our team earned 1st and/or 2nd team honors in their spots for singles and doubles.
