1. **Baseball** - Baseball season has started and is in full swing. We had to reschedule our youth clinic and modify our Mustang Day At The Ballpark due to the cold weather but everyone seemed to have fun! Varsity home game on Monday the 21st. Our website is fully updated with all baseball information. Financially we are in good shape - P & L approved
2. **Basketball – Boys** – Finished season last night and now working on end of season banquet. Good season. P & L approved
3. **Basketball** – Girls Varsity girls finished 9-7 (4th in district) Played a talented Beaumont United this past Monday in the bi-district round of playoffs and lost 39-58. Banquet will be held at La Brisa on Monday, March 7. P & L approved

6. **Country/Track/Field – Boys** - Varsity boys track got the 2022 track & field season off to a good start this past Friday, finishing 5th in a strong field of 13 teams at the Pearland Morriss Invitational Track Meet. The guys were one of only three 5A schools at the meet, and still were able to come away with strong performances on the track as well as in the field. We will travel to Barbers Hill for this week's meet. P & L approved
7. **Cheerleaders** – We have had an exciting month. On January 23rd, the competition team won NCA High School Nationals in the Large Varsity division. It has been 9 years since FHS Cheer brought home an NCA National Championship. It took a lot of practice and dedication from the girls and patience from our coaches to help them achieve this accomplishment. We have our cheer clinic fundraiser on Saturday and have over 160 girls registered to spend the morning with us. Our Formal is Saturday evening at the Lakewood Yacht Club, we are holding our banquet on March 3rd at the First Baptist Church and we are preparing for tryouts the week of March 7th. If anyone is interested in trying out, we have a mandatory meeting on Tuesday, February 22 at 6:30pm at the Cheer Shack. Our financials are balanced and reconciled
8. **Football** – Football's PNL is good. Friendswood Football was named as a finalist for the Touchdown Club of Houston's Sportsmanship Award. We also have an athlete named as a finalist for the Touchdown Club of Houston's Scholar-Athlete award
9. **Golf - Boys** got 4th at the Barbers Hill tournament and jv girls got 3rd at Texas City - P & L approved
10. **Lacrosse – Girls** – PNL is reconciled. We had an amazing time at Aggieland with a championship win in our division. This was a great start to the season. We have created Fan shirts and hope to raise some money with the sale of these shirts. We are also providing yard signs for the players. We have had to reschedule our games due to the freeze and some conflicts with upcoming games etc., but are now on track for the season. Our first home game is on Saturday, February 26th at 4 pm. The girls team went to the boys Varsity home game last week and had a great time.
11. **Lacrosse – Boys** - Financials are in order. FHX boys lacrosse season is off to a great start. After losing the first 2 games of the season, the team has gone on a 4 game winning streak. Coach Benson has wins versus Bellaire, St. Thomas, Clear Springs and Seven Lakes. Combined score of 47 – 20. Next games will be on the road at Strake Jesuit and Cy Woods




**xi. New Business:**
