- Baseball PNL is reconciled -District play is in full swing... we just need the weather to cooperate. We were able to sell all of our fan gear and although our 'Mustang Day at the Ballpark' was cancelled in February due to weather - our special events and auction items have been a great success.
- 2. Basketball Boys- PNL is reconciled. March 8th we enjoyed our end-of-year banquet. We celebrated a couple of our athletes with awards: 1st team all-district: Mason Petrovics and Troy Barnes and 2nd team all-district Keagan Robertson and Academic all-district Aiden Stokes, Jeff Schoettelkotte, Garrison Fritts, and Jackson Fiesinger. We also have three awards specific to basketball: 3D AWARD -Garrison Fritts MVP- Troy Barnes and Mason Petrovics and Mr. Clutch- Troy Barnes. And now we are ON TO THE OFF SEASON!
- 3. Basketball Girls End of season banquet was held. Several girls were selected to the alldistrict teams.
- 4. Track Girls PNL is reconciled Our track and field season is going strong. The meet on this Friday is our last meet before district. We finished off our Team Driven online fundraiser and were able to deposit a check for almost \$6000 into our booster club account. Our end of year banquet will be held on May 25th.
- 5. Country/Track Boys Boys' Varsity track came in third place against all 6A teams at their last track meet before spring break held at Clear Creek HS. This week's meets are the last regular season meets before heading to districts. We are starting to plan for our end of season banquet that will be held in May. PNL are reconciled.
- 6. Cheerleaders PNL is reconciled. We completed tryouts 2 weeks ago and are excited for the new year! Our JV squad, comprised of incoming freshman and sophomores, totals 19 girls and our Varsity squad, comprised of incoming juniors and seniors, totals 25. New squad practices start April 4th, as they prepare for camp in June. The current squads are working on their Spring Show routine. We held our end of year banquet on March 3rd at First Baptist Church, it was a beautiful evening.

- 15. Swimming / Diving / Water Polo PNL is reconciled On Feb 18 & 19 the FHS swim team competed at State. The girls came in 3rd place and the boys came in 16th. The Girl's 200-Free Relay won 1st place and are the new state champions in this event. Swimmers in this event were: Andi Jeanes, Peyton Becker, Abigail Nelson, KK LeBlanc (1st). There were two medalists in individual events: Tony Laurito who placed 1st in the Boy's 200 Individual Medley event and is the new state champion and KK LeBlanc who placed 2nd in the Girl's 50 Freestyle event. Water polo season has started. The boys team and girls team both competed in the Ascension Tournament on Feb 24-26. The girls had 4 wins and 0 losses. The boys had 1 win and 3 losses.

Both teams also competed in the Wyatt Earp Tournament on March 3-5. Both teams had 1 win and 1 loss.

X. Old Business:


