Baseball-Baseball reconciles with our PNL. In the process of selling banner sponsorships

renovation, fans hung in the batting cages and working equipment like balls and field
maintenance. Season is just around the corner!

- 2. Basketball Boys –This past weekend your Mustangs went down to Corpus to compete in the Tuloso Midway tournament. In the first game, the Mustangs fought hard, but ultimately came up short to Victoria West. We then won by forfeit, setting up a matchup with Brazosport. The Mustangs beat Brazosport by a score of 50-29. The Mustangs were led in scoring by Jackson Fiesinger (Sr.) who had 14. With the win, the Mustangs faced Corpus Christi London in the Consolation Championship. JV WON the Clear Brook JV tournament and had stellar play from all players. The Sophomore team went 2-1 to finish 3rd. It was a great weekend for the Mustangs, as all teams were able to bring home a trophy! All 5 teams will be back in action tomorrow at Deer Park! - 4. Cross Country (B&G) & Track and Field (Boys)- off season, they are going to start a fundraisers (fan shirts)
- 5. /Field Girls There's nothing new to report for Girls Track & Field
- 6. Cheerleaders –Our account is reconciled. Our 2 NCA teams competed on Nov. 20 and both came in 1st place. We hosted our Mother/Daughter Tea last Saturday. The girls are concentrating on cleaning up the routines so they are prepared for UIL Spirit Championships and NCA Nationals beginning the week we return from break. We've had no major expenditures this past month except for competition deposits
- 7. **Football** –Football is out of season so there isn't much to report. We have only been preparing for our banquet.
- 8. Golf The Varsity Boys finished 1st at the Dawson tournament on Monday shooting their season low of 314. Bryce Brazzel finished 1st shooting a 76. He has finished in the top 2 in the last two tournaments. The Boys also finished 2nd at the Pearland Invitational the previous week. The Girls Varsity finished 1st at the Pearland Invitational for the 3rd year in a row. This is the girl's 2nd first-place finish of the young season. The JV Girls finished 1st place at the Bayou Fall Scramble shooting a 74. PNL Reconciled
- 9. Lacrosse Boys- PNL Reconciled. The off season is going great. New players are learning and developing lacrosse skills. Boys played in the Victory Best of Texas Lacrosse tourney in the Woodlands 12/10 and 12/11. Records didn't indicate how valuable the tournament was to our overall success later in the regular season. Boys competed against some very good select teams across the state. We got a lot of valuable playing time for the new players as well as bonding experience for the team. The FHS Girls and Boys Swim and Dive team competed at the annual Hornet TISCA (Texas Interscholastic Swim Coaches Association) Meet at Flour Bluff High School in Corpus Christi on November 18th and 19th. Twenty-eight Friendswood swimmers qualified and attended this Invitational Meet. Both Mustang Girls and Boys finished 3rd among a field of 17 high schools in the 5A and 6A division. Friendswood Swimmers broke 4 Flour Bluff pool records during the meet (Boys 200 Medley Relay - Tony Laurito, Nick Hardt, Lane Jordon, Marshall Odom, Girls 200 Free Relay Peyton Becker, Andi Jeanes, Lauren Tillman, KK LeBlanc, Girls 50 Free KK LeBlanc, Boys 100 Free Marshall Odom). On December 6, 2022 FHS hosted a swim meet against Richmond Foster, Galveston Ball, and LaPorte High Schools. Both the girls and the boys won. Our next meet is on Dec 17th when we will host 5 area teams for the annual Mustang Holiday Splash. From a Booster perspective: We coordinated plans with Coach Sikkema for the meet in Corpus Christi including meal plans. Booster paid for the hotel rooms and meal allowance for 2 nights through a transfer to Activity Fund. We offered a meal option for our away meets (paid for by parents using Paypal). Whenever FHS hosts a meet the Booster reps find 25-35 volunteers for each meet. We also opened a second Spirit store for some parents that missed our original one in August.
