iii. President's Report –

a. Good evening and happy October! We are coasting right through 2025.

We are so excited to announce what items we have chosen to be purchased with the \$10,000 general funds overage! We worked closely with Coach Johnson in hearing what items affected the most amount of athletes or were in a dire need of replacement.

- Soccer Jugs Machine/Generator (impacts 109 players/2 coaches)

- A 3rd Glute Machine for the weight room (affect 900 athletes/2 coaches)

- Watercow for ALL outdoor sports (affects 340 athletes/52 coaches/trainers)

- Long jump/Triple Jump Pit covers (affects 25 athletes/1 coach)

- Tempo Trainers (we will order as many as possible with the remaining \$10,000, if funds allow)

b. We spent many hours and had many meetings working through how we could best impact our sports and athletes, and our goal is to continue down the list with extra funds at the end of the year. Take pictures of the athletes using new equipment and Beth will post.

c. Stadium chairs were a hit, and we sold a total of 50 chairs. Track, wrestling, boys soccer, cheer and boys basketball all participated. Thank you for sharing the links. Almost half of the chairs sold were by a specific sport and the \$25 per chair will be transferred to those sports accounts. Profit on these two as approx. \$1400! Thank you for your support.

d. Communication with your coach is imperative. The relationship with you and your coach should be one that thrives in trust and communication. In season, you should be communicating multiple times a week. In the off season, once a week. Many issues and confusion can be avoided and will make our organization and your sport run more smoothly.

1. Baseball - Baseball wrapped up their fall ball season. We are currently making plans to attend a tournament in College Station early next year. The Alumni Association will be hosting Bingo night November 15. All proceeds will be donated back to the program. PNL is reconciled.
2. Basketball – Boys - Boys basketball recently purchased new practice uniforms for Varsity and JV. We also purchased new travel suits for the entire program. FMBC has positively impacted our program by supporting our fundraising efforts. We have had to replenish our gear from when it was damaged by the construction of the new gym and our fundraising has been instrumental in us being able to do that. We are still working with Tracey to verify that our P&L corrections were updated.
3. Basketball – Girls - GBB Booster funds are currently being utilized to prepare for the Basketball Tip-Off Event on 10/29. Additionally, we are preparing for the season and planning for upcoming tournaments. The P&L statement is in the process of being reconciled. We are working with the Treasurer to ensure corporate sponsorship funds have been received as well.
4. Cross Country (B&G) - Cross Country is using booster funds to provide food for the team as they travel to Region and onto State. We are also planning our end of season banquet.
5. Cheerleaders – we purchased food and entertainment for our annual football dinner, signs and materials for competitions, competition registration, and hotel rooms for athletes. weeks are reconciled
6. Football – The Booster Club remains committed to supporting our athletes by providing food and snacks throughout the season. Planning is also underway for our end-of-season banquet, where we'll celebrate our players, coaches, and accomplishments. I would like to get an update on concession stands for next year

- d. Bylaws- Need to vote on several proposed changes. Proposal to eliminate 1st VP and Secretary term limits (to be voted on at the November meeting).
- e. Raffles- As a 501(c)(3), the organization is only allowed four raffles per year across all sports. Proposal for stand-alone raffles—each sport may request to host one, but total raffles cannot exceed four per year. Sports must email the board to file a raffle request. The board will review requests to ensure no overlap and confirm availability. If needed, raffles can be changed from two in fall to two in spring. Raffles must be pulled the same day as the event.
