1. Baseball - Baseball booster funds are being used for our upcoming Christmas game and toy drive. Our PNL is reconciled
2. Basketball – Boys - Boys basketball is using FMBC funds to replace program gear that was ruined during gym construction. We recently purchased new practice uniforms, game day travel gear and team backpacks. We also purchased a JBL PartyBox for the locker room/aux gym. Our P&L is reconciled.
3. Basketball – Girls - With our season now in full swing, the Booster Club is providing meals and snacks for our players and coaches during tournament play. Varsity will participate in two tournaments this month, while the JV and Freshman teams will each compete in one. Last month's Tip-Off Event was a huge success! We had an amazing turnout (including more than 100 GBB and BBB Buddies and their

families), for a fun, high-energy evening that included shooting contests, scrimmages, and the always-popular slam dunk contest. It was a fantastic kickoff to the season and a great opportunity for our athletes to connect with our Friendswood community. Our account is reconciled.

Friendswood Mustangs Booster Club Senior Scholarship Procedure

1. Alignment Between Booster Representatives & Coaches

Before submitting scholarship information, Booster Representatives must meet with Coaches to finalize:

- Scholarship recipients
- Individual scholarship amounts
- Total program allocation
- Presentation date/event

Reps and Coaches must be in full agreement before proceeding.

2. Required Email Submission

Once aligned, the Booster Representative must email the FMBC Treasurer including:

- Full list of scholarship recipients
- Amount awarded to each senior
- Total program dollar amount
- Presentation location/date

CC the following:

- Coach
- Athletic Director
- Assistant Athletic Director
- FHS Principal

3. Change Management

After the submission email is sent, no changes may be made unless:

- All individuals included on the original email are notified
- All parties acknowledge the revision
- All parties approve the change

4. Principal Approval Requirement

Any individual scholarship over \$250 requires explicit approval from the FHS Principal, documented in the email thread.

5. Record Retention

The FMBC Treasurer will retain all approval emails. Booster Representatives should also keep a copy for their program records.
