iii. President's Report –

a. Happy New Year to everyone! I hope you had a fantastic Christmas and New Years with friends and family. This school year is halfway over but we still have a lot to tackle before May!

- x. In the 5 years I have been a part of FMBC we have worked so hard to get everything running correctly and make it as easy as possible for our reps to be successful. We worked so hard so that this transition that we knew was coming, would be a smooth one.

- xii. Also, athletics has received most of the items we ordered as our donation in September! We are still waiting on the hamstring machines (custom builds when ordered) and the Juggs machine.

iv. Marketing/Concessions

a. Concessions:

- i. Stand Liquidation Timeline: Once Soccer has concluded and the one potential meet I will begin the process of liquidating all Booster purchased items in the Athletic & Band Concession stands. 95%+ of all items in the stands were purchased with Booster funds, and I will work with Jackie to confirm receipted ownership prior to selling the equipment. All proceeds from the sales will go back into the general booster fund. I will repeat this process with the Visitor stand once baseball has concluded. The sale of items will first go to the Booster club teams, then the school/clubs, then district, and finally the general public. Beth will manage the sales process.

Q&A: Shiela (football) asked about the status of Aramark confirming their running of concessions for the 2026-2027 season. Ava responded that she has reached out multiple times asking for a status update but has still not received any information back. She will follow up again with the school after this meeting. Beth reiterated that due to the Booster Member's vote we have made it clear we would not continue providing concessions management into another school year as we have provided the additional school year requested and so the liquidation is the final piece to adhering to that vote.
