- a. Hey everyone and welcome to the March meeting! We have a special guest, Mr. Thad Roher, our Superintendent, with us tonight and he will chat with us about the new proposed bond.
 - b. As we are gearing up to close out this year, we still do not have a President for FMBC, for next year. Moving into the next meeting if we still do not have a willing volunteer, we will start to discuss how to proceed and likely the disbandment of FMBC. This is not ideal, and I hope that someone is moved to step up and take over and head this amazing organization that we have worked diligently to rebuild and earn the trust of our supporters, parents, coaches, community and school district. In addition to earning the trust of all those who have stood by FMBC, we have provided a strong connection between athletics and our booster, to help purchase large ticket items that sports would not be able to purchase on their own, including items that affect all 900+ athletes. All of this while helping take burden from our reps, to allow their primary focus to be on their sport and growing funds for their sport's specific athletes. As an umbrella booster, we, the board, take on the hard tasks of making sure your athletes are UIL eligible, we are nonprofit eligible, we organize the required documents, forms, meetings, agendas, minutes, taxes, etc. Our board of 5, and what we handle, will become each of your individual sports, YOU AS REPS, responsibilities. This isn't a guilt trip, it's factual. Role of President isn't a hard one, it's one that just asks that you be able to see booster as a whole and not focus on one sport individually. I spend maybe 5 hours a week on a busy week, handling booster items.

 - d. Our stadium chair fundraiser was successful for our spring drive! We sold a total of 41 chairs (we still have one available). 9 of those chairs were sold directly by track and we will have your funds transferred before the close of the semester.

- e. Total profit to FMBC for this fundraiser was approx \$1280. These proceeds go to help build funds for scholarships and wish lists directly for our student athletes.
